What will you need? We have a kit that has most of the basics for you. You may have other crafty supplies that you can add to your cards. Some additional things that you will find useful:

- ☐ Ruler
- ☐ Pencil – just a normal lead pencil
- ☐ Eraser
- ☐ Small and large scissors
- ☐ Black biro / felt tip pen

If you have access to these it might help too;

- ☐ Gel pens
- ☐ Paper trimmer
- ☐ Small curved scissors
- ☐ You might like stronger glue like PVA or no mess double sided sticky tape

No kit – just join us on Zoom – you may already have supplies (Blank cards and envelopes, papers, card stock, bling, washi tape, ribbon, glue etc) and if you find that you need a few extra pieces you can pop out and grab some things now the shops have re-opened!!
