Card: Christmas Light

Sujatha Harding inspired this card.

Materials

- Base card
- Coloured circles
- Gold straw
- Rhinestones / bling, holly
- Glue stick, foam double sided squares and scissors

Instructions

We all learn in different ways – some will prefer the video and others like some written guidance. These instructions are designed to guide you – feel free to add in your own creative ideas and ways of doing things.

1 Get 3 different sized circles, all different colours and position them together – use the glue stick to glue them together. On your metallic card draw a flame – don't forget to give it a "neck" which will sit inside your straw.

2 Cut the gold straw to the length you need. Flatten it and glue the flame into the top.

3 Position everything on the card. Stick the circles down with glue stick – everything else I have used the double-sided foam blocks – these have good "stick" for the straw and holly. If they are a bit big – just cut them in half.

4 Choose the sentiment (Christmas message) you like – I liked "May his light shine in your heart throughout the year". I used the red paper and cut it just a bit bigger than the sentiment to make it standout.

5 Bling it up! I added red rhinestones on the holly and a silver one over the "I" of light.

I quite like the pearl finish of the cards – so I have kept it quite plain. This design looks great with a dark background too - so have fun making this card the way YOU like ②.
