

Card: Christmas Hills and Trees

I love this card as it's simple and fun – who doesn't like "Bling"!!

Materials

- Base card
- Metallic card
- Green paper or card
- A Christmas sentiment
- Rhinestones / bling
- Glue stick and scissors

Instructions

We all learn in different ways – some will prefer the video and others like some written guidance.

These instructions are designed to guide you – feel free to add in your own creative ideas and ways of doing things.

1. Cut a strip of the metallic card the width of your base card. Your piece of metallic card should be at least one and a half longer than your card.



2. Turn the metallic card to the white side and we are going to create the gentle rolling hills background. About half-way down your card draw a wavy line which will be your hills (use pencil so no one can see it!). Then mirror this line below twice to make the other hills. Cut along the wavy lines.



3. Position your background on your card. Start with a metallic background, use the reverse side to create contrast for the next piece, metallic and then white.



4. Using the green paper cut some green triangles out and position them in the rolling hills. Once you are happy with how they look – use the glue stick to stick them all into place – start with the largest metallic piece of card at the back and gradually work forward.



5. Choose a sentiment (Christmas message) and carefully cut round it.

I used the foam stick pads to stick it on – it just gives it a little more dimension.

6. Bling it UP! I used the silver self-adhesive rhinestones to decorate it. Put as many on as you like!
